Fundamentals of Aviation and Flight

45 hours of instruction, 3 college credits

For high-school students 14 – 16 years old

Learn about the principles of aviation and flight in an exciting program that combines in-class sessions, hands-on learning at the Athens International and Megara airports, and flight lessons with a state-of-the-art flight simulator.

Prerequisite: Fundamentals of Aviation and Flight or Equivalent



Flight Operations

45 hours of instruction, 3 college credits

For high-school and college students

Flight Operations is designed for students who are interested in a career as a pilot. Using classroom instruction and experiential learning, the course covers the first half of the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) Private Pilot License Syllabus and prepares students to begin formal flight training.

- Airport Operations & Air Traffic Management at Athens International Airport
- Flight Operations & Aircraft Maintenance at Megara General Aviation Airport



Global Aviation Management & Operations

45 hours of instruction, 3 college credits

For high-school and college students

Designed for students interested in a career in the global aviation industry, this course provides an overview of the diverse aspects of aviation management and operations. It covers key aspects of the international aviation system, including regulation and international conventions and explores topics such as safety, environmental and security management.

- Aviation Safety and Accident Investigation at Air Accident Investigation and Aviation Safety Board (AAIASB)
