Christina Founta is a graduate of the Medical School of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. She completed her PhD and specialty training in Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University Hospital of Ioannina. Christina subsequently moved to the United Kingdom, where she undertook subspecialty training in gynaecological oncology and the diagnosis of gynaecological cancers. She has contributed to multiple clinical studies, leading to publications in international journals, presentations at UK, European and international conferences, and involvement in the development of clinical guidelines.



Since 2017, Dr Founta has held Consultant posts within the NHS. She is currently a Consultant in Gynaecological Oncology at Guy's & St Thomas' Hospital, London, where she previously led the Colposcopy Service and the Rapid Access Clinic. Since 2021, she has also practised in Greece as a private specialist and as one of the lead clinicians in the colposcopy clinic at Mitera Hospital.

Her professional focus is the delivery of personalised, evidence-based, high-quality care, alongside improving women's health literacy to reduce anxiety, enhance quality of life, and strengthen effective screening and prevention of gynaecological cancers.
