Athens is a vibrant modern metropolis with a thriving arts scene, and a fulcrum of the ongoing debate on the meaning and future of Europe. A meeting place of East and West, Athens remains an affordable, safe and friendly Mediterranean city, where life is lived outdoors in the squares and sidewalk cafés of its many, diverse neighborhoods.



OVERVIEW

Join us in our four-week summer session. Students attend our experiential, traveling course “A Walk Across Greece” and one/ two courses from our undergraduate General Education courses or any core or elective degree course.

“A Walk Across Greece” is an experiential learning course offered intensively over the span of one week. The course takes students on a journey across the country for a series of interactive excursions exploring the history of Greece through day hikes, walking tours, and guided visits to regional museums, historical sites and famous monuments. Traveling from the Homeric epic of the Bronze age to the 19th century War of Independence, students follow the footprints of 5,000 years of history, covering over 1,000 kilometers of geography (6 cities and 2 islands).
